Learning Days

On Friday the 16th November the whole school will be off timetable taking part in one of our Learning days. This year we have arranged a trip for Year 10 to the Natural History Museum in London for the morning followed by bowling at Finchley bowling alley in the afternoon.

The Natural History Museum is located in South London and during our visit we will look at the specimens from the natural world. To support students in understanding the process of evolution, we will look at the many fossil samples they have. We will also look at the human body to help students to understand about the different organ systems in the body and how it functions.

We will be leaving school at 08:30am on the 16th November and return to school by 4pm. Please provide students with a packed lunch and a drink. Students will need to be wearing their school uniform.

The cost of the trip is £16.50 which includes coach travel, a study guide for the museum and bowling. Entry to the museum is free.
