Year 10 GCSE Geography Fieldwork Trip to Hunstanton – Thursday 20th June 2019

A Geography field trip to Hunstanton has been organised for Year 10 students on Thursday 20th June 2019. We will be leaving The Priory School at 8.00am returning between 5.30pm and 6.00pm.

The purpose of the trip is to ensure all Year 10 GCSE students have the appropriate primary data and experience of a fieldwork enquiry to complete their GCSE Geography Paper 3.

Whilst in Hunstanton, students will answer the following two questions;

1. How successful are groynes at controlling longshore drift?
2. What are the environmental impacts of tourism at Hunstanton?

Taking part in this trip will put students in a strong position to answer the fieldwork investigation questions in their final GCSE Geography paper - which is worth 15%.

The cost of the trip is £16 which includes coach travel and a CGP Revision Guide for the new AQA 9-1 GCSE Geography course. Please make payment and consent via ParentMail.

Students will require a packed lunch and water on the day. Students may wear casual clothing but will need comfortable footwear.

The Priory School reserves the right to remove any student from the trip prior to leaving if their behaviour deteriorates once they have been accepted.

If your child is due to have an additional pre-paid music lesson on this day, they will need to rearrange the lesson with the Music Department.
